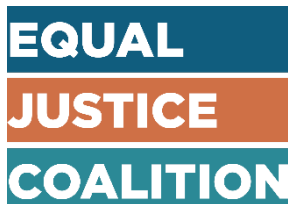


CAMPAIGN FOR EQUAL JUSTICE
