The Legal Foundation of Washington is a non-profit organization created in 1984 at the direction of the Washington Supreme Court to fund legal aid services to low-income people in Washington. We seek to ensure access to civil legal aid for all people in Washington, and to improve the civil justice system to be more equitable and just.

We serve thousands of low-income people each year by investing in civil legal aid organizations across Washington. Since 1984, LFW has distributed more than \$200 million to Washington's legal aid community. Last year, we funded over 40 nonprofit legal aid providers serving over 31,000 clients statewide.

Goldmark Distinguished Service Award to an individual or organization that has assisted in providing deep and meaningful access to the justice system.
