Prior to becoming Solicitor General, Noah worked at Perkins Coie in Seattle where he handled Voting Rights Act cases including a case that reformed Yakima's city council elections. Noah also led the appeal of the Stormans case on behalf of patients seeking access to emergency contraceptives, and has handled pro bono matters on behalf of juvenile immigrants and constitutional litigation. After graduating magna cum laude from Harvard Law School, Purcell worked as a law clerk to former U.S. Supreme Court Justice David Souter.
