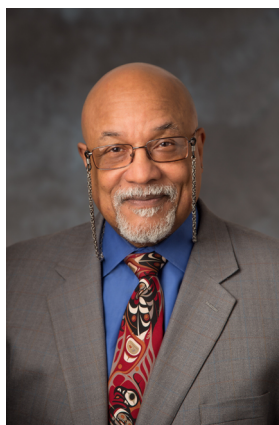

JUDGE J. WESLEY SAINT CLAIR (RET.)

Judge Saint Clair wants to end youth detention. He served on the King County District Court 1991 to 2004 when he was appointed to King County Superior Court by Governor Gary Locke. In 2012, he joined King County Juvenile court, where he presided over Truancies, Juvenile Drug Court, Offender Calendars, and Trials as Chief Juvenile Judge. He retired March 2019. Judge Saint Clair has been active in the courts concerning technology, community engagement, and treatment and was recognized for his work in drug courts by *The New York Times* and is on the Board of the National Association of Drug Court Professionals.
