Assistant Public Defender, City of Spokane

Born in Nigeria, Francis has served as Assistant Public Defender since May 2001. He serves as co-chair of the Spokane County Regional Law & Justice Council's Racial Equity Disparity Subcommittee, board member of Spokane County Bar Association and the Volunteer Lawyers Program, and is VP of JustLead Washington. He was appointed by Governor Inslee to a three-year term on the Washington Statewide Reentry Council in 2016 and was reappointed in 2019. He helped establish the Spokane Community Court and received the City of Spokane Human Rights Award in 2013. Francis, along with other members of the Spokane Community Court, were recipients of the 2018 WSBA Apex Awards.
